A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PFLUGERVILLE, TEXAS AUTHORIZING A TEEN COURT AS AN ADDITIONAL ALTERNATIVE AT PFLUGERVILLE MUNICIPAL COURT FOR JUVENILE DEFENDANTS AGES 10-17 OR THOSE WHO ARE ENROLLED IN AN ACCREDITED SECONDARY SCHOOL IN A PROGRAM LEADING TOWARD A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA, AND ESTABLISHING A FEE

WHEREAS, Teen Courts are used in Municipal Courts throughout the state of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the Pflugerville City Council asked Municipal Court Judge Farren Sheehan to determine the viability of a Teen Court in Pflugerville; and

WHEREAS, Teen Courts provide an alternative to traditional Municipal Court options by emphasizing community service which dispenses juvenile cases in a positive and effective manner while educating teens about the law; and

WHEREAS, Teen Court holds the teen accountable for actions by taking personal responsibility while benefitting from positive peer interaction; and

WHEREAS, Judge Sheehan and Associate Judge Caroline Davis attended Teen Court training to learn about the advantages and administration of a teen court.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL THAT:

- 1. The Pflugerville City Council establishes a Teen Court as an alternative for juvenile defendants between the ages of 10-17 or those are enrolled fulltime in an accredited secondary school in a program leading toward a high school diploma.
- 2. A fee of \$20 will be charged for participation in Teen Court to cover the costs of administration for the Teen Court as allowed by state law.
- 3. The Pflugerville City Council shall formally review the Teen Court program in August 2020.
