Worksession

1. Call to order

Mayor Victor Gonzales called the worksession to order at 5:00 p.m. Councilmembers Doug Weiss, Jeff Marsh and Jim McDonald were in attendance. 2. Discuss only

Items were addressed in the order as recorded in the minutes.

2B. <u>2019-7577</u> Legislative update and discussion.

Ms. Breland provided a written summary of the legislation and impact to the city and provided introductory information. Brandon Aghamalian and Snapper Carr of Focused Advocacy provided a recap on the legislative session and answered questions of the Council. There was discussion on the item.

2C. 2019-7622 Discussion related to the FY20 budget regarding Transit Development Plan Implementation.

Mr. Fletcher provided information on the city's current transit spending. He asked for direction on the implementation of the Transit Development Plan adopted in August 2018 and options for demand response (ride-share opportunity), local fixed route and Austin express service and reviewed the cost estimates. Michelle Meaux, Capital Metro, provided input. Council discussed the fixed route partnership concept for a Pflugerville express bus with Ms. Meaux. Mr. McDonald read an email from Ernest Tomes asking for door to door transportation services for those like himself that are blind and others who need it. Mayor Gonzales suggested that the city collaborate with Hutto and Travis County to make the costs more palatable. Mr. Heath stated

that they need to look at the numbers and the ridership, that there may be more effective ways. Mr. Marsh asked if it is justifiable at a cost per head. He stated a need to weigh the cost. Mr. McDonald stated a need to look at these needs in the community. There was continued discussion.

2A. <u>2019-7629</u>

1.) Executive Session Item: Consultation with legal counsel pursuant to Section 551.071 of the Texas Government Code for discussion regarding contractual issues relating to the Weiss Lane Roadway Project.
