#### **General:**



I definitely don't know enough. Thank you for these lists and for the direct curated list link! Reserved a copy to pick up and start.



## Donations, etc.:

The library has received 1,581 items for the Curbside Care Kits and has given out 98 kits. Kits generally consist of combs, hair ties, toothbrush, toothpaste, toilet paper, shampoo, soap, band aids and a mask. Items in individual kits may vary depending on availability.



The library also received a donation of \$300 from the Falcon Point Unofficial Facebook Group to support our collection of anti-racism books.

#### Accreditation

The library has again met and exceeded the criteria for accreditation with the Texas State Library.
