#### **LOCAL SERVICE**





#### MetroBus | Routes 1-499 & 600-699

- Frequent-stop service all over town
- Flyer routes with fewer stops and faster service

## MetroRapid | Routes 801 & 803

- Frequent service with limited stops and faster travel times
- Service on Austin's busiest corridors:
   North Lamar to South Congress (801) &
   Burnet Road to South Lamar (803)

#### **COMMUTER SERVICE**



#### MetroRail | Route 550

- Commuter rail to & from downtown
- Nine (9) stations between Leander and downtown Austin



## **MetroExpress** | Routes 900 - 999

- Commuter bus to & from downtown
- Service from Park & Rides outside the city to central Austin, downtown, UT & several employment centers.

#### PARATRANSIT SERVICE





#### **MetroAccess**

- Demand-response, shared-ride service for people whose disabilities prevent them riding regular bus or rail service
- "Paratransit" refers to transit that is parallel to fixed-route bus service.

#### **METRORideShare**




- Groups of 4 to 12 share monthly cost
- You find a Volunteer Primary Driver
- A wide array of vehicles (7, 8 or 12)
- Comprehensive insurance
- Maintenance & Repairs
- 24-hour roadside assistance
- Online ride matching tool
- Optional "Guaranteed Ride Home"
- Groups with an origin or destination outside the Capital Metro service area are eligible to receive a \$450 monthly subsidy.
- Shared cost of the monthly lease, fuel, tolls and any other commute-related expense
- Monthly cost depends on vehicle type chosen by the group, commute distance and number of riders.






# **On-Demand Transportation**

- Alternative to regular bus






# Selecting a Zone


