RESOLUTION CALLING A BOND ELECTION FOR NOVEMBER 3, 2020; MAKING PROVISIONS FOR CONDUCTING THE ELECTION; AND RESOLVING OTHER MATTERS RELATED TO SUCH ELECTION

WHEREAS, on February 11, 2020, the City Council of the City of Pflugerville, Texas (the "City") adopted a resolution (the "February Resolution") calling a bond election to be held in the City on May 2, 2020 (the "May Bond Election");

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, the Governor of the State of Texas (the "Governor") certified that the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) posed an imminent threat of disaster and, under the authority vested in the Governor by Section 418.014 of the Texas Government Code, declared a state of disaster for all counties in Texas (the "Disaster Proclamation"); and

WHEREAS, on March 18, 2020, in furtherance of the Disaster Proclamation, the Governor issued a proclamation (the "March Election Proclamation") suspending Sections 41.0052(a) and (b) of the Texas Election Code to the extent necessary to allow political subdivisions to move their previously ordered special elections from May 2, 2020 to the next uniform election date on November 3, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on April 2, 2020, the City Council adopted a resolution (the "April Resolution") pursuant to the March Election Proclamation postponing the May Bond Election until November 3, 2020 and requiring the City Council to meet no later than August 17, 2020 to make the necessary or desirable revisions to the February Resolution, with any revisions to the proposition and ballot language and such additional propositions, if any, for the election as the City Council may determine to be appropriate at such time; and

WHEREAS, on July 27, 2020, in furtherance of the Disaster Proclamation, the Governor issued a proclamation (the "July Election Proclamation") suspending certain provisions of the Texas Election Code for elections held in Texas on November 3, 2020 to provide additional time for early voting; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it advisable to adopt this resolution as contemplated by the April Resolution to hold a bond election on November 3, 2020 as set forth in this Resolution (the "Election"), and this resolution supersedes and replaces the February Resolution in all respects with regard to all bond propositions of the City to be voted on at the Election; and

WHEREAS, the City is contracting with Travis County and Williamson County (collectively, the "Contracting Counties") for the administration of the Election pursuant to interlocal agreements with the Contracting Counties (each an "Election Contract"); and

WHEREAS, Travis County, acting through the Travis County Elections Administrator (the "Travis County Elections Administrator") in accordance with the Election Contract will provide for the administration of the Election for residents of the City residing in Travis County; and Williamson County, acting through the Williamson County Elections Administrator (the "Williamson County Elections Administrator" and together with the Travis County Elections Administrator, the "Elections Administrators") in accordance with the Election Contract will provide for the administration of the Election for residents of the City residing in Williamson County;

WHEREAS, it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution was adopted was open to the public, and public notice of the time, place, and purpose of the meeting was given, all as required by Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, as amended (the "Open Meetings Act"), and as further modified by an order issued by the Governor on March 16, 2020, suspending certain provisions of the Open Meetings Act in light of the Disaster Proclamation.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PFLUGERVILLE, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1. Findings. The statements contained in the preamble of this Resolution are true and correct and adopted as findings of fact and operative provisions hereof.

Section 2. Election Called; Polling Places. The Election shall be held in the City between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on November 3, 2020 ("Election Day"). The Election is to be conducted by the Contracting Counties, as provided by Chapter 271, Texas Election Code (the "Code") and the respective Election Contracts. Voting for the Election on Election Day shall occur during the hours and at the designated polling places as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto, which exhibit is hereby made a part hereof for all intents and purposes. Exhibit A shall be modified to include additional or different Election Day polling places required to conform to the Code and the respective Election Contracts.

Section 3. Early Voting. Early voting shall be administered by the Contracting Counties. Early voting by personal appearance shall begin in accordance with the July Election Proclamation on October 13, 2020 and conclude on October 30, 2020, and will be conducted at the Early Voting locations on the dates and at the times specified in Exhibit A attached hereto. Exhibit A shall be modified to include additional or different early voting polling places required to conform to the respective Election Contracts and the Code.

Section 4. Election Officials. The appointment of the Presiding Election Judges, Alternate Judges, Early Voting Clerks, the Presiding Judge of the early ballot board and other election officials for the Election shall be made by the Elections Administrators, as applicable, in accordance with the Election Contracts and the Code. The Elections Administrators may employ

other personnel necessary for the proper administration of the Election, including such part-time help as is necessary to prepare for the Election, to ensure the timely delivery of supplies during early voting and on Election Day, and for the efficient tabulation of ballots at the central counting station. The City Council of the City hereby authorizes the Mayor, the City Manager, and the City Secretary, to execute or attest on behalf of the City the Election Contracts with the Contracting Counties.

Section 5. Voting by Mail. Applications for voting by mail for all residents of the City shall submitted by personal delivery not later than October 16, 2020, or shall be mailed to the address below and received (not postmarked) by October 23, 2020.

Section 6. Early Voting Ballots. An Early Voting Ballot Board shall be created to process early voting results of the Election and the Presiding Judge of the Early Voting Ballot Board shall be designated by the Elections Administrators. The Presiding Judge of the Early Voting Ballot Board shall appoint two or more additional members to constitute the Early Voting Ballot Board members and, if needed, the Signature Verification Committee members required to efficiently process the early voting ballots.

Section 7. Qualified Voters. All qualified electors of and residing in the City, shall be entitled to vote at the election. Last day for eligible voters who are not yet registered to vote to submit their applications for registration is October 5, 2020.

Section 8. Propositions. At the Election the following PROPOSITIONS shall be submitted in accordance with law:

"Shall the City Council of the City of Pflugerville, Texas, be authorized to issue bonds of the City, in one or more series or issues, in the aggregate principal amount of \$101,700,000 with the bonds of each such series or issues, respectively, to mature serially within not to exceed forty years from their date, and to be sold at such prices and bear interest at such rates, as shall be determined within the discretion of the City Council, in accordance with law at the time of issuance, for the purpose of constructing, improving, extending, expanding, upgrading and/or developing transportation projects comprised of City intersection improvements, City neighborhood street reconstruction, Immanuel Road, FM 685 corridor improvements, SH 45 frontage roads, Kelly Lane, Pfluger Farm Lane North, Main Commerce Drive, **Picadilly** Street, Central Drive, Weiss Lane extension/realignment with Cameron Road, East Pflugerville Parkway and East Pecan Street, including utility relocation, sidewalks, traffic safety and operational improvements, the purchase of any necessary rights-of-way, design costs and related drainage and other related costs; and shall said City Council be authorized to levy and cause to be assessed and collected annual ad valorem taxes on all taxable property in the City in an amount sufficient to pay the annual interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund to pay the bonds at maturity?"


"Shall the City Council of the City of Pflugerville, Texas, be authorized to issue bonds of the City, in one or more series or issues, in the aggregate principal amount of \$42,300,000 with the bonds of each such series or issues, respectively, to mature serially within not to exceed forty years from their date, and to be sold at such prices and bear interest at such rates, as shall be determined within the discretion of the City Council, in accordance with law at the time of issuance, for the purpose of constructing, improving, extending, expanding, upgrading and/or developing parks and recreation projects comprised of trail improvements, neighborhood parks, land acquisition, Lake Pflugerville, 1849 Park, and destination play space, including design costs and related drainage and other related costs; and shall said City Council be authorized to levy and cause to be assessed and collected annual ad valorem taxes on all taxable property in the City in an amount sufficient to pay the annual interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund to pay the bonds at maturity?"

"Shall the City Council of the City of Pflugerville, Texas, be authorized to issue bonds of the City, in one or more series or issues, in the aggregate principal amount of \$47,300,000 with the bonds of each such series or issues, respectively, to mature serially within not to exceed forty years from their date, and to be sold at such prices and bear interest at such rates, as shall be determined within the discretion of the City Council, in accordance with law at the time of issuance, for the purpose of constructing, improving, extending, expanding, upgrading and/or developing a recreation and senior center, including design costs and related drainage and other related costs; and shall said City Council be authorized to levy and cause to be assessed and collected annual ad valorem taxes on all taxable property in the City in an amount sufficient to pay the annual interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund to pay the bonds at maturity?"

Section 9. Ballots. The official ballots for the Election shall be prepared in accordance with the Code so as to permit the electors to vote "FOR" or "AGAINST" the aforesaid PROPOSITIONS with the ballots to contain such provisions, markings and language as required by law, and with such PROPOSITIONS to be expressed substantially as follows:

Section 10. Compliance with State and Federal Law. In all respects, the Election shall be conducted in accordance with the Code, the July Election Proclamation and any future proclamations of the Governor impacting the Election. Pursuant to the federal Help America Vote Act ("HAVA") and the Code, at each polling place there shall be at least one voting system that is equipped for disabled individuals, and each such voting system shall be a system that has been certified by the Texas Secretary of State as compliant with HAVA and the Code. The City hereby finds that the voting system to be used by the Elections Administrators in administering the Election is such a system, and orders that such voting equipment or other equipment certified by the Texas Secretary of State shall be used by the City in its elections.

Section 11. Debt Obligations. The following information is provided in accordance with the provisions of Section 3.009(b) of the Code.

- (a) The proposition language that will appear on the ballot is set forth in Section 9 hereof.
- (b) The purpose for which the bonds are to be authorized is set forth in Section 8 hereof.
- (c) The principal amount of the debt obligations to be authorized is set forth in Sections 8 and 9 hereof.
- (d) If the bonds are approved by the voters, the City Council will be authorized to levy annual ad valorem taxes, on all taxable property in the City, sufficient, within the limits prescribed by law, to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds and the cost of any credit agreements executed in connection with the bonds.

- (e) Based upon the bond market conditions at the date of adoption of this Resolution, the maximum interest rate for any series of the bonds is estimated to be 3.75%. Such estimate takes into account a number of factors, including the issuance schedule, maturity schedule and the expected bond ratings of the proposed bonds and notes. Such estimated maximum interest rate is provided as a matter of information, but is not a limitation on the interest rate at which the bonds or notes, or any series thereof, may be sold.
- (f) If the bonds are approved, they may be issued in one or more series, to mature serially, over a period not to exceed 40 years from the date of issuance of each series of bonds.
- (g) The aggregate amount of the outstanding principal of the City's debt obligations secured by and payable from ad valorem taxes as of the date of this Resolution is \$250,060,000.
- (h) The aggregate amount of the outstanding interest of the City's debt obligations secured by and payable from ad valorem taxes as of the beginning as of the date of this Resolution is \$128,037,830.
- (i) The ad valorem debt service tax rate for the City as of the date of this Resolution is \$0.1872 per \$100 of taxable assessed valuation.

The information provided in this section is solely for purposes of compliance with Section 3.009(b) of the Code and is for illustration purposes only. The information is not a part of the propositions to be voted on and does not create a contract with the voters.

Section 12. **Posting and Publication Requirements**. The City Secretary is authorized to give or cause to be given notices required for the election, and to take such other and further action as is required to conduct the election in compliance with the Code and City Charter; provided that, pursuant to the Election Contracts, the applicable election officials of the Contracting Counties shall have the duty and be responsible for organizing and conducting the election in compliance with the Code; and for providing all services specified to be provided in the Election Contracts. The applicable election officials of the Contracting Counties shall give the notices required by the Code to be given for the election not required to be given by the City under the Election Contracts.

In accordance with provisions of the Code, the forms of voter information documents pertaining to propositions to be voted on at the Election are attached hereto as <a href="Exhibit" B" (the "Voter Information Documents"). A substantial copy of this Resolution and the Voter Information Documents (each as may be modified without further City Council action in a manner that is consistent with the calling of the Election and the election notice requirements of the Code applicable to the Election, including any proclamations by the Governor) shall serve as proper notice of the election and the voter information documents required by Section 1251.052(b), Texas Government Code, respectively. The City Secretary is authorized to give or cause to be given the following to be posted and published in accordance with law:

- (a) A substantial copy of this Resolution, with such omissions authorized by law, shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City, on the same day in each of two successive weeks with the first publication occurring not earlier than the thirtieth (30th) day or later than the fourteenth (14th) day prior to the day of the Election;
- (b) This Resolution and the Voter Information Documents shall be posted not later than the 21st day prior to the date set for the Election (i) on the bulletin board used for posting notices of meetings of the City Council (and also at City Hall if such bulletin board is located elsewhere) and (ii) at three other places in the City;
- (c) This Resolution and the Voter Information Documents shall be posted on election day and during early voting by personal appearance, in a prominent location at each polling place; and
- (d) This Resolution, the Voter Information Documents and any sample ballot prepared for the Election shall be posted during the 21 days before the election, prominently on the City's Internet website.

Each of this Resolution and the Voter Information Documents shall be published and/or posted, as provided above, in both English and Spanish translations. All notices provided as required by this Resolution shall be modified as necessary to take into account any future proclamations issued by the Governor impacting the Election.

- (1) Interest on the proposed bonds under Proposition C was calculated at a weighted average interest rate of 3.75% based on market conditions as of August 11, 2020, and therefore, the actual interest payable on such proposed bonds may be less than, or more than, the amounts set forth above based on market conditions at the time of sale of the proposed bonds to be authorized under Proposition C.
- (2) Assumes the proposed bonds under Proposition C will be sold at their par amount of \$47,300,000. If Proposition C is approved by the voters, upon the actual sale of the bonds, the principal amount of bonds sold may decrease based on market conditions at the time of such sale.
- (3) Aggregate of all outstanding obligations of the City secured by and payable from ad valorem taxes as of the date of August 11, 2020. Such amount also includes obligations which the City currently intends to pay from sources other than ad valorem taxes but that could be paid from ad valorem taxes if such other sources are not available at the time required for payment.

Based on the information and assumptions provided in the table above, the estimated maximum annual increase in the amount of ad valorem taxes that would be imposed on a residence homestead in the City

with a taxable appraised value of \$100,000 to repay the proposed bonds to be authorized under Proposition C is \$18.32. This estimate assumes (i) annual growth of the City's taxable assessed valuation at a rate of 6.0% through tax year 2023 and 2.0% through tax year 2028, and holds the City's taxable assessed valuation constant thereafter, (ii) assumes that the proposed bonds will be issued in an amortization that will produce relatively consistent levels of debt service in each year and (iii) assumes the issuance of an additional \$27,375,000 in principal amount of debt obligations to be paid from ad valorem taxes that are anticipated to be issued by the City prior to the November 2020 election.
