RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PFLUGERVILLE, TEXAS ADOPTING A MULTIPLE USE AGREEMENT WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE TEMPORARY USE OF THE MOKAN RIGHT OF WAY

- **WHEREAS**, the City of Pflugerville is proposing the installation of a temporary drive that is not more than 20 feet wide to serve a COVID-19 testing site within the Mokan ROW, extending approximately 415 feet north of FM 1825, locally known as Pecan Street; and
- **WHEREAS**, it is a requirement of the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) that any municipality constructing improvements located within TxDOT right of way enter into a Multiple Use Agreement; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City of Pflugerville will maintain all City constructed improvements within the TxDOT right of way, ensure there is no tracking of material onto the roadway infrastructure, and shall remove material and restore area to existing or better condition at the end of use which shall not exceed 24 months.

NOW, THEREFOR, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PFLUGERVILLE:

That the City of Pflugerville hereby adopts effective the date, the TxDOT Multiple Use Agreement associated with the installation of a temporary drive that is not more than 20 feet wide to serve a COVID-19 testing site the Mokan ROW, extending approximately 415 feet north of FM 1825, locally known as Pecan Street, attached as Exhibit A.
