2020 Transportation GO Bond



The issuance of \$101,700,000 bonds by the City of Pflugerville, Texas, for transportation projects for City intersection improvements, City neighborhood street reconstruction, Immanuel Road, FM 685 corridor improvements, SH 45 frontage roads, Kelly Lane, Pfluger Farm Lane North, Main Street, Central Commerce Drive, Picadilly Drive, Weiss Lane extension/realignment with Cameron Road, East Pflugerville Parkway and East Pecan Street. For the \$101.7 million transportation bond, the estimated maximum annual increase is \$39.39 per \$100,000 home valuation.



Overview

- The City issued a Request for Qualifications (RFQs) for consulting engineering services on November 11th.
- The City received eight (8) Statements of Qualifications (SOQs) from interested firms on December 17th.
- A Selection Committee made up of City Staff reviewed and scored the SOQs based on the RFQ scoring criteria.
- The top two (2) firms based on the SOQ scoring were interviewed by the Selection Committee on January 14th.
