

# Highland Park Wastewater Interceptor

- Construction of 1,400 LF 36-inch and 1,500 LF of 24-inch wastewater interceptor near Pflugerville Parkway and Pfluger Farm Lane
- Decommissioning of two wastewater lift stations and ultimately reducing maintenance and operation costs
- Connecting Sewershed to the newly constructed SH-130 Wastewater Interceptor
- The estimated construction period:
  October 2021 to July 2022





## **Bid Alternatives**

1. Additive Alternate No. 1 (A1) substitutes 24" Polyvinyl chloride (PVC) Pipe in lieu of 24" Fiberglass Reinforced Pipe (FRP)

- 2. Additive Alternate 2 (A2) includes remobilization for lift station decommissioning, if required due to downstream project schedules
- 3. Additive Alternate 3 (A3) substitutes 36" FRP in lieu of 33" FRP
- 1. Deductive Alternate 1 (D1) includes open cut rather than trenchless near the Highland Park Lift Station, if field conditions allow.
