Mr. Wade provided an introduction. Mr. Hemenes presented and answered questions regarding the 1849 Park project, funding and annual operation and maintenance cost. Mr. Hemenes provided information regarding projects to be funded by existing reserves and certificates of obligation funding to include the Gilleland Creek pool house and restrooms, Bohls House, Recreation Center, and Wilbarger Creek Park. Mr. Heath recommended doing a full city facility survey and to include the requested Recreation Center and Senior Center study with the rest for prioritization. Mr. Hemenes concluded that he would like to reallocate funds for the projects as discussed with the same funds already in place. He answered additional questions of the Council. Council asked regarding constructing a new facility instead of making improvements to the Bohls House. Mr. Hemenes said that it will take some investment to make it usable for any use. Council discussion followed.
