**2A.** <u>RES-0601</u> Discuss a resolution adopting special purpose district creation consent policies.

Ms. Barron provided a draft resolution and Council discussed their recommended changes to the draft policy. Ms. Barron, Ms. Breland and Mr. Fletcher participated in the discussion. A resolution for Council's consideration was to be brought forward to the next Council meeting.

**2B.** <u>2019-7400</u> Discussion regarding mobile food vendors (food trucks).

Ms. Barron provided information on the August 2018 to December 2018 pilot program and discussed with the Council. Mr. Marsh suggested continuing the pilot program for a while longer.

**2C.** <u>2019-7409</u> Discuss policies related to dockless vehicles programs associated with bicycles and motorized scooters.

Mayor Gonzales stated that he thinks that there are opportunities and that scooters could be considered an option for transportation. Mr. Marsh recommended a moratorium while other cities are finding solutions to issues and creating a model. There was continued discussion. Ms. Breland indicated that she would not bring the topic forward again unless requested by the Council.
