The City is amending Chapter 71 of our Code of Ordinances relating to parking on city streets by removing the Temporary No Parking zones established in the following areas for roadway construction activities. At this time, all referenced projects have been completed and the Temporary No Parking zone should be revoked.

- 1. Portions of the Heatherwilde and Windermere Subdivision streets
- 2. Black Locust Drive from it's intersection with Grand Avenue Parkway to it's intersection with Heathwerilde Boulevard
  - 3. Portions of the Heatherwilde Subdivision streets

A map depicting the temporary designated no parking zone streets is attached to this item.
