Authorizing the City Manager to execute a conditional purchase agreement and associated conveyance documents between Franklin Stiba and Ruby M. Stiba and the City of Pflugerville as necessary to acquire real property interests for the Pfennig Lane Roadway Improvements Project.

The Pfennig Lane Roadway Improvements Project requires property acquisition, including the acquisition of right of way necessary to construct the project. The City’s property acquisition consultant and city staff have negotiated with Franklin Stiba and Ruby M. Stiba for the needed right of way. The cost of \$33,277.25 for a conditional purchase agreement has been agreed upon, subject to City Council approval, based on negotiations between the property owner and City.

Approval of this item will authorize the City Manager to execute a conditional purchase agreement and associated conveyance documents necessary for formal conveyance of the real property interests.

The City Attorney has reviewed and approved the language of the purchase agreement.

Fiscal Impact

Funding for this project is from the 2014 general obligation bonds.

Staff Recommendation
