Review representation and discuss and consider action to appoint three representatives to the Capital Area Council of Governments (CAPCOG) General Assembly.

The City of Pflugerville is over 50,000 in population and therefore qualifies for three positions on the CAPCOG General Assembly. Currently, Councilmembers Mike Heath, Ceasar Ruiz, and Doug Weiss are appointed to serve on the General Assembly as the City of Pflugerville's representatives. This item has been included on the agenda to allow the City Council to review its representation and take action to change representation.

The next meeting of the CAPCOG General Assembly will take place on Wednesday, December 14, 2022.

Only members of the CAPCOG General Assembly can be appointed to the CAPCOG Executive Committee. The appointments to the CAPCOG Executive Committee are made by CAPCOG.

The General Assembly meets at least twice per year.
