Discuss and consider action to approve a Resolution Ratifying the Property Tax Increase Reflected in the City's Fiscal Year 2022 Operating Budget.

Pursuant to Section 102.007(c) of the Texas Local Government Code, a municipality is required to take a separate vote to ratify the property tax when the adoption of the budget will raise more property tax revenue than in the previous year.

At the Council proposed rate of \$0.4970, the FY22 budget will raise more property tax revenue than last year's budget by \$3,439,063 (10.7%) and of that amount \$1,363,450 is tax revenue to be raised from annexations and new property added to the tax roll this year.

Prior City Council Action

The City Council approved a proposed maximum property tax rate of \$0.4970/\$100 property valuation on August 10, 2021.

A public hearing and adoption of the tax levy ordinance were held earlier in this meeting.

This additional action is required to complete the property tax rate approval.
